The permittee is responsible for carefully reading the permit in detail and becoming familiar with all of the changes therein:

- 1. PAA disinfection is replacing chlorine disinfection. An instantaneous maximum concentration and monitoring requirements for PAA have been added to the permit
- 2. A decimal place has been added to some limits to comply with the OWQ's updated rounding policy.
- 3. Monitoring frequency reduction language has been added to Part II of the permit.
- 4. Total Phosphorous and Nitrates plus Nitrites as Nitrogen monitoring and reporting requirements have been added to the permit.
- 5. Total Phenols monitoring requirements have been removed from the permit.
- 6. The WET dilution of 45% has been corrected to 42%.
- 7. The Schedule of Compliance has been removed.
- 8. The SSO language has been updated.
