Dear Sir or Madam,

Ash Grove Cement Company, a Division of CRH (Ash Grove) operates a cement kiln in Foreman, Arkansas, with an NPDES permit (permit number: AR0042846). The permit requires both a 24-hour, and a 5-day report when results exceed the limits. On May 5, 2021, Ash Grove made the 24-hour report. The information herein completes the 5-day report (See permit Part III Section D.6).

The permit requires monthly outfall data on pH. On May 5, a sampling event found results greater than the maximum limit of 9.0 pH.

Outfall 001 pH Maximum: On May 5, Ash Grove measured a pH sample at Outfall 001 at approximately 9:46 A.M. The pH value was 9.1, which is above the permit's maximum limit. Ash Grove reported to DEQ on May 5, at 3:01 P.M.

Ash Grove will reach out to either FTN Associates or GBMc & Associates to help with its investigation into the pH exceedance at Outfall 001 and to identify potential measures to put in place to prevent future exceedances.
