Subject: temporary bio solids change

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Alan,

I wanted to follow up our conversation this morning with an email to document our problem and proposed solution.

Our existing solids handling train is to take solids from our clarifiers to a centrifuge to our dryer and out to bulk bags for holding class A EQ product until a bulk hauler comes to take a trailer load out.

Two weeks ago we needed to shut the dryer down for planned maintenance which was completed over a week. During this time, we wasted our solids to two 800,000 gallon aerated sludge storage tanks. When we tried to start the dryer back up, a new problem won't allow us to operate the dryer and we are waiting on parts. We are trying to get parts from two different sources and neither can give us a firm delivery, but our storage will run out by the end of next week.

Our proposed solution as discussed on the phone is to get in contact with some of our past class B sludge haulers and try to arrange a temporary hauling operation to relieve our situation and get caught up. We will of course do the necessary class B testing and documentation. As soon as we are able, we will be producing class A again as this is a less expensive way to operate for us.
