Proposed Amendment No. 001 to Consent Administrative Order LIS 16-097**

Dear Mayor Vann:

On December 1, 2016, the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) and the City of Magnolia (City) entered into Consent Administrative Order (CAO) LIS 16-097. Pursuant to CAO LIS 16-097, the City agreed to achieve compliance with permitted effluent limits by December 31, 2016. On December 22, 2016, with additional information received on March 6, 2017, the City submitted an updated Corrective Action plan and requested an extension of the date of final compliance with permitted effluent limits to December 2018. After careful consideration, ADEQ is willing to accept this request.

Enclosed is a copy of the revised CAO in this matter. If you choose to accept the terms of the CAO, please sign, date, and **return the original, embossed copy** to the address below **within (20) calendar days** of receipt of this letter. A City Council Resolution that approves the CAO and authorizes the Mayor and Clerk/Treasurer to sign the CAO on behalf of the City of Magnolia must also be submitted. Subsequently, the Director of ADEQ will sign the CAO and you will be provided a copy, including information on the public notice process and the effective date of the CAO.

Failure to contact the ADEQ, Office of Water Quality, Enforcement Branch in response to this CAO **within (20) calendar days** of receipt of this letter, will constitute rejection of the settlement offer and unilateral enforcement action may proceed through a Notice of Violation (NOV).
