Mr. Hinchey:

As described in your July 17, 2023 letters to Richard Healy and myself, DEQ acknowledges that the June 28, 2023 effluent sample which had approximately 10.0 mg/L total residual chlorine (TRC) was the major cause of lethal and sub-lethal toxicity to *P. promelas* and *C. dubia* in the June 2023 WET tests.

DEQ acknowledges that City of Clinton has investigated the source of the high TRC and attributes it to bleach cleaning of sampling equipment by a new to the position employee.

DEQ acknowledges the corrective action of additional training of the new to the position employee.

DEQ acknowledges that an acute screening test on a June 30, 2023 effluent sample passed.

No additional corrective actions for this issue are needed at this time.

As per the NPDES permit Part II.9.B.i.a "The permittee shall conduct a total of three (3) retests for any species that demonstrates significant toxic effects at or below the critical dilution. The retests shall be conducted monthly during the next three consecutive months..."

These three retests must be conducted in July, August, and September 2023.
