Letters were sent to the facility on **February 2, 2023 and November 1, 2022**, informing you that the discharge permit for **Arkansas Electric Cooperative Corporation Magnet Cove Generating** Station (*AR0049611*) will expire on **October 31, 2023**. In order to continue discharging past the permit expiration, a complete permit renewal application **MUST** be submitted to the Division 180 days prior to the expiration date, by **May 4, 2023**.

Anytime the reminder letters go out, we try and reach out to the permittee to ensure that they are receiving the letters and are aware of the due date. If the Division does not receive a complete permit renewal application by **May 4**, **2023**, the only way to grant permit coverage until a new permit is issued, is through a Consent Administrative Order, which will include a civil penalty. That is why we try and reach out to make you aware of that due date and the importance of making sure the renewal application is received on time.
