We feel this problem was due to:

The site has been in the process of moving the scalehouse facilities from the central portion of the site to the northern portion of the site. The soil disturbance in these upstream areas, as well as the increased heavy equipment traffic could have increased sediment in the stormwater that ultimately flowed to the pond.

We plan on correcting the problem in this manner:

The scalehouse relocation project has been completed. Our stormwater consultant is pulling samples this week to determine what type of polymer floc log would be required for installation upstream of the pond, if structural BMPs are warranted.

Time estimated that it will take to correct problem:

We should have the results of the samples and recommendations for floc logs by the end of June. If warranted, the logs could be purchased and installed in July.
