We feel this problem was due to:

~~Initially inadequate maintenance of sanitary treatment system due to COVID-19 upset to staffing levels. Then carryover of fecal levels in back end of treatment system. Pumping out and cleaning with chlorine shock of back end components failed to correct the problem.~~

We plan on correcting the problem in this manner:

~~We have retained an Environmental Management Services, Inc. (engineering consulting firm) to investigate operating history and current conditions, and oversee necessary maintenance to improve operation; then make design improvements if necessary. Their work is ongoing as of January 2021.~~

Time estimated that it will take to correct problem:

~~If new treatment system is required, process of design, permitting, and installation could take 6-12 months~~
