Dear Mr. Campbell:

The application for a no-discharge permit was received on August 5, 2015. In accordance with Department policy, your application has been reviewed and determined to be incomplete. The deficiencies are described below. Information to satisfy the deficiencies must be received by the Department no later than **two weeks from the date of this letter** before processing of your application can begin. Failure to submit the required information will result in your application being placed in an inactive status.

• The permittee's legal name (owner/organization name on application) shall be consistent on the permit application and disclosure statement with permittee name on file. The permittee on file is Ellis Campbell.

If you find that you are unable to meet the deadline, you may request, upon receipt of this letter, in writing a reasonable extension to the deadline above addressed to the Engineering Supervisor of the No-Discharge Section of the Water Division or by email to water-permit-application@adeq.state.ar.us. The Department will inform you whether your request is approved or refused.

Nothing in this request shall preclude the Department from requiring that additional information be submitted in order to complete processing of your application. Performing an activity without the permit required by state and federal regulations may subject you to an injunction and penalties.
