In the past 20 years, the number of monitored waterways showing impairment has gone from 45% to 55% & the leading cause (according to EPA) is ~~non~~ point source pollution primarily by Agriculture.

The Buffalo River was seeing effects of runoff back in the 1990's - & a study by NPS concluded that it would be a leading threat to the River's Health. Now in 2016, we've added millions of gallons of land applied Hog waste to the watershed. We were assured by Farm Bureau & other "experts" that waste from C & H would not cause degradation.
