When will this end? Who will monitor all this waste that they propose to apply to new pastures, and who will verify that these pastures are appropriate for that much waste? If resources are already stretched thin, how are we to believe that more areas can be observed and measured, not to mention reported to the public?

I have heard so many complaints about this hog operation and ADEQ's handling of the process, from the speedy granting of permission to build in the first place, to acceptance of shoddy research practices, to refusal to view expert information that counters ADEQ's decisions, to refusal to recognize affected waterways as impaired -- what is wrong with this system? Whose interests are being served here? Not, it is obvious, the people of Arkansas.
