Dear Ms. Bartlett:

The Arkansas Department of Energy and Environment - Division of Environmental Quality, Office of Water Quality (OWQ) received your letter requesting a 90-day extension on your permit application deficiencies. The OWQ still requires the items in the July 6, 2021, letter in order to process your application. The OWQ grants this extension. Please submit your information to the OWQ by October 18, 2021. If the OWQ hasn't received the requested information by that date, your application will be forwarded to the Enforcement Branch of the OWQ.

The Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act (A.C.A. Sec. 8-4-101 et seq.), as amended, requires that any waste disposal system that does not discharge directly into waters of the state must be under the terms and conditions of a no-discharge water permit. The permit renewal application must be updated according to the letter dated July 6, 2021, and re-submit to the OWQ in order to continue the renewal permit process.
