Applicant: City of Cave Springs, P.O. Box 5, Cave Springs, AR 72718. Location: The Creeks Golf Course near U.S. Hwy 112 in Cave Springs; Latitude: 36° 15′ 2″ N Longitude: 94° 14′ 30″ W.

This permit is for the operation of a decentralized waste water treatment system with drip irrigation dispersal for a residential subdivision. This type of systems is also classified as Class V shallow injection wells under the provisions of APCEC Regulation No. 17.
