Incompleteness Letter Response – Extension Request

Dear Mr. Solaimanian,

Deficiencies of the City of Cave Springs' No Discharge Permit Renewal, as outlined in the incompleteness letter dated March 24th, 2017, will require longer than the granted 2-week period to correct. It is the opinion of McClelland Consulting Engineers, Inc. that in order to produce the requested revisions and documentation, the city will require no less than a one month extension from the date of this letter. The following corrective actions will be taken as outlined by the incompleteness letter within the requested extension time frame:

- 1. Providing an updated Waste Management Plant, stamped by a Professional Engineer, addressing the following items:
 - a. Treatment processes of plant 1 and 2
 - b. All connections to the system
 - c. All zones and their loading rates
 - d. Cover crop for each drip field
 - e. Depth to groundwater
- 2. Providing a Corrective Action Plan (CAP) stamped by a Professional Engineer and addressing the following violations reported in the Monthly Monitoring Reports (DMRs), specifically:
 - a. CBOD5
 - b. Total Suspended Solids
 - c. pH
 - d. Fecal Coliform

Thank you for your time and consideration of a deadline extension. The extension will allow McClelland to properly assist the city in determining the best possible course of action to comply with permit requirements now and in the future. Please contact me at your earliest convenience with questions or concerns regarding this letter.
