2. Request by certified mail (as described previously) or email to water-permit-application@adeq.state.ar.us to withdraw your permit application until you have satisfied the requirements and then reapply at a later time.

If the information is not provided in a timely manner, your application may be placed in an inactive status. Upon receipt of the information requested on the reverse of this page, your application will be determined to be complete, and processing of your application will continue.
