As a Newton Co resident, I oppose the Reg 5 Permit for the C&H Hog Operation. The pasture land where the hog waste is applied consists of either steeply sloping terrain underlain by karst or, are streamside bottomland fields which are subject to flooding, increasing the risk of pollution due to water runoff. And, the hog waste is spread on the pastures year round instead of only when the pasture forages are growing. The land here is not suitable for this type of hog operation.

The Buffalo National River draws many tourists which greatly improves the local economy versus just a few jobs created by the hog operation. Many local businesses rely on tourism revenue.

Arkansas can not risk losing one of it's most valuable, beautiful rivers for the sake of a hog production operation.
