I am writing to express my concern about the recent application of C&H Hog Farms for a Regulation 5 permit to operate 6 miles upstream from the Buffalo National River. I have been studying the following points presented by the Buffalo River Watershed Alliance, and agree with their conclusions.

- 1) As shown by the Watershed Alliance material, it is obvious that granting a No-Discharge permit is inappropriate;
- 2) It has been shown that there is Karst below this site, which is not recognized in the application;
- 3) The application does not comply with the AWMFH;
- 4) The application ignores evidence of present discharge;
- 5) There is a moratorium in place, which is also ignored by this application; and
- 6) The Nutrition Management Plan is obviously deficient, as outlined by the Alliance.

The above issues seem to be a pattern on the part of ADEQ, for some reason, that is aimed at allowing contamination of the Buffalo. Why this should be, I cannot imagine. I strongly urge you to deny this permit.
