Dear Mr. Withrow,

For the July 2012 WET test it has been noted that the value reported on the DMR for the *P. promelas* (TOM6C) and *Daphnia pulex* (TOM3D) NOEL parameters are not in line with what is reported in the WET test report provided by the testing laboratory (Bio-Analytical).

The summary page provided by the testing laboratory for the WET test report also appears to be erroneous.

Table 1 Section 3.0 Results and Discussion on page 6 of 35 reports the percent survival for all 6 dilutions at 0.0% for both organisms.

Appendix C pages 24 of 35 and 25 of 35 both report significant differences from the control for all 6 dilutions for both organisms.

A corrected DMR is required for the July 2012 WET test. Please revise the NOEL parameters (TOM6C and TOM3D) to reflect the NOEL of 0% and submit the corrected DMR to the Department. Additionally please take steps to prevent this type of error in reporting for future tests.
