

NPDES Permit Conditions for Accepting Building Product wastewater

1. The NPDES permit is issued to the Consumer Products and Paper (CP&P) mill. Should company divestitures split the CP&P mill from the Building Products (BP) facilities in the complex (Chemical plant, Stud mill and Plywood plant) then the NPDES permit will remain with the CP&P mill. The CP&P mill, as permit holder, will enter into and maintain an agreement with the BP facilities for the discharge of the BP facilities' effluent into the wastewater treatment system. The agreement will state that the Chemical plant, the Stud mill and Plywood plant will meet the applicable wastewater requirements of Arkansas DEQ regulations. The agreement will also establish monitoring requirements for parameters in the BP facilities' effluent. The agreement will also address the notifications that the BP facilities must provide to CP&P and the ADEQ in the event of potential changes in its discharge due to new significant dischargers, or changes in their wastewater characteristics.
2. The Agreement with the BP facilities will stipulate that monitoring records will be maintained for a minimum of three years to ascertain compliance with the Agreement.
