Georgia-Pacific LLC (GP) submitted an NPDES permit renewal application on May 4, 2015. The permit renewal application included increased off machine production, measured in machine dried tons per day, as compared to the previous permit basis. Under 40 CFR 430.22, this would allow for increased permit limits for BOD₅ and TSS that could be included in a new permit.

However, after a review of our treatment system performance, GP is agreeable to maintaining the permit limits for BOD₅ and TSS that are in the current permit, and foregoing the increase in limits. We reserve the right in any future permitting actions to request an increase in BOD₅ and TSS limits based on production increases.
