Sludge Pond Closure Plan

Dear Ms. Johnson,

I am writing in response to your request to Ms. Loretta Reiber to dispose of solids from waste water basins in a sludge pond as part of a continuing closure plan. The Solid Waste Management Division ("SWMD") has reviewed the information available to us regarding the sludge pond closure plan. SWMD has been informed that a sludge closure plan has been utilized to dispose of waste water basin sediments since around 1995.

Based on the facts available it is the determination of the SWMD that the implementation of the sludge pond closure plan could constitute disposal of solid wastes at a disposal site other than a facility for which a permit has been issued by ADEQ. Disposal of solid wastes at an unpermitted facility is a violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 8-6-205(a)(3).
