Dear Mayor Gardner:

The application for renewal of your expiring NPDES permit was received on January 30, 2023, with additional information received February 1, 2023. In accordance with Division policy, your application has been reviewed and determined to be administratively complete on February 1, 2023.

All permits are issued in accordance with federal and state priorities for water pollution abatement. Therefore, it is possible that the processing of this application for permit renewal may take some time depending on the relative priority of the discharge in comparison with others. However, every effort will be made to expedite the processing of your permit. In the event that a renewal permit is not issued prior to the expiration date of your current permit, your expiring permit will continue in effect after the expiration date because you have submitted an administratively complete renewal application at least 180 days prior to the expiration date of your current permit (as required in 40 CFR 122.21(d) and APC&EC Rule 6.201). You must continue to meet your existing permit requirements until a renewal permit is issued.

Pursuant to Act 163 of 1993 and Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission (APC&EC) Rule 8.205, public notice must be given for all permit applications submitted to this Division. The enclosed public notice will be published by DEQ in a newspaper of general circulation for one (1) day only. An invoice for the cost of publishing the public notice and proof of publication will be sent to you by the advertising newspaper. The permittee must send proof of publication and payment to the address at the bottom of this letter as soon as possible but no later than 30 days from the above date. Until this Division receives proof of publication of the public notice, no further action will be taken on the renewal of your discharge permit.
