The application for renewal of your NPDES permit was received on January 30, 2023. In accordance with 40 CFR 122.21 and APC&EC Rule 6, your application has been reviewed and determined to be incomplete. Please complete the following:

- 1. The outfall location must be marked on the topographic map.
- 2. As the responsible official, you must sign EPA Form 2A.

These forms must be completed and received by the Division no later than February 1, 2023. Failure to submit the required information will result in your application being placed in an inactive status.

Please be advised that a complete application must be received by February 1, 2023, for permit coverage to continue past the expiration date (July 31, 2023) in accordance with 40 CFR 122.21(d) and APC&EC Rule 6. Consequently, failure to provide the information requested could result in an unpermitted discharge upon expiration of your current permit and subject you to enforcement action by the Division. Upon receipt of the information requested, your application will be determined to be complete, and processing of your renewal application will begin.
