Dear Mayor Marberry:

The application for modification of your NPDES Permit and for issuance of a State Construction Permit was received on November 9, 2020, with additional information received by December 1, 2020. A request was received on May 27, 2021 to change the referenced permit modification application of NPDES Permit AR0021717 to a revoke and reissue application. Since all submitted information received by May 27, 2021 satisfies the completeness requirements of a revoke and reissue application, and a complete application has been submitted within 18 months of the expiration of the current NPDES Permit, the permit will be revoked and reissued as requested.

All permits are issued in accordance with federal and state priorities for water pollution abatement. Therefore, it is possible that the processing of this application for permit renewal may take some time depending on the relative priority of the discharge in comparison with others. However, every effort will be made to expedite the processing of your permit. In the event that a renewal permit is not issued prior to the expiration date of your current permit, your expiring permit will continue in effect after the expiration date because you have submitted an administratively complete renewal application at least 180 days prior to the expiration date of your current permit (as required in 40 CFR §122.21(d) and Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission [APC&EC] Rule 6.201). You must continue to meet your existing permit requirements until a renewal permit is issued.

Pursuant to Act 163 of 1993 and APC&EC Rule 8.205, public notice must be given for all permit applications submitted to this Division. The public notice which was placed in *The Mountaineer Echo* in Marion County on December 31, 2020, fulfills this requirement. Any additional information required to be in a public notice will be included in the public notice for the draft permit.
