This email is regarding NPDES discharge permit No. AR0034037 – City of Yellville. The permit authorizes the discharge was treated sanitary wastewater from the wastewater treatment facility. The renewal application for renewal of the NPDES discharge permit was received on July 21, 2014 and was placed on administrative hold due to mineral water quality criteria concerns and was not reissued at that time.

DEQ mailed a letter around September 10, 2020 requesting a complete DEQ Form 1 and EPA Form 2A including the sampling requirements. As of this date, DEQ had not received anything. If no information is submitted by November 6, 2020, DEQ will use the renewal information received on July 21, 2014 to renew the NPDES discharge permit. If the City requires additional time to complete the forms, please let me know before November 6, 2020.
