
Dear Mr. Starks:

The authorization for land application of biosolids in the above-referenced NPDES discharge permit has expired. If you wish to continue the land application activities, you must have permit coverage. The forms and instructions for applying for a No-Discharge land application permit have been enclosed for your convenience. Please submit the application for the land application of biosolids as soon as possible but no later than thirty days from the date of this letter. Please also let the Department know if you wish to discontinue biosolids land application at this facility.

If you find that you are unable to meet the deadline, you may request, upon receipt of this letter, in writing a reasonable extension to the deadline above addressed to the Engineer Supervisor of the No-Discharge Section of the Water Division or by email to water-permit-application@adeq.state.ar.us. The Department will inform you whether your request is approved or refused.
