I am writing to respond to the January 19, 2010 letter from Frances McSwain of The Department of Arkansas Heritage to Kim Fuller of the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality regarding the above-referenced matter ("Letter").

According to the Letter, your department has records indicating that two archeological sites (3PU28 and 3PU416) may be affected by our proposed work. The Letter also states that "3PU416 is not eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places and requires no further archeological work, but the eligibility of 3PU28 is undetermined."

We have engaged the services of a professional archeologist to evaluate site 3PU28 to identify its current status and determine whether it will be affected by the planned undertaking. URS is pleased to provide you with this letter proposal to provide archaeological services for the abovereferenced site and matter described in a letter dated January 19, 2010 to Ms. Kim Fuller at the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) from Frances McSwain, the Deputy State Historic Preservation Officer at the Arkansas Historic Preservation Program (AHPP). Based on the letter from the AHPP, a site visit to evaluate the current status of 3PU28 is warranted, and then a report of the findings should be submitted to the AHPP. Phase I investigation is not likely, since your property was previously developed and used as an industrial site prior to purchase by Caterpillar Inc. Because the AHPP did not give any specific site information on 3PU28 in their letter, this needs to be a three step process.

- 1. We need to conduct the background research and find out some specific information about the site- e.g. how big is it, how was it recorded, how long ago it was recorded, if prehistoric or historic
- 2. Then based on the answers to these questions, we will be able to decide what the site visit should entail (e.g. photo documentation and/or limited excavations, how many people, etc).
- 3. The results would need to written up in a report and submitted to the AHPP.
