I request that ADEQ deny the permit being considered for the Paradise Valley sewage facility and I request a public hearing. The revised draft permit would allow pollution of a pristine wetlands area, Mill Bayou and its tributaries. The sewage facility would endanger drinking water, livestock, wildlife and the environment. Maumelle Water Corporation (MWC) has asked repeatedly for a study to determine the sewage facility's impact on the aquifer that supplies their wells. That crucial study has not been performed and is not addressed in the revised draft permit. It appears that MWC's request is being ignored. This is insane!

If clean drinking water is not a concern for the tax-paying citizens out here in Roland, what is next?

Please hold a public hearing. Thank you.
