I'm extremely concerned that a sewage facility as planned has not been shown to sufficiently protect Mill Bayou from pollution, and that pollution may enter the water table and aquifer as well and contaminate Roland's water. Mill Bayou can be dry at times, like this summer during our months-long drought. It can also flood. I'm concerned that the planning doesn't cover these eventualities.

I'm also concerned that a developer with a history of noncompliance with federal regulations is being allowed to seek such a permit.

The governmental response here has been completely inadequate. Please deny this permit, and hold a public hearing so all concerns can be heard.
