I respectfully request that ADEQ deny the permit for the sewage treatment facility for Paradise Valley and I also request a public hearing on this issue. Mill Bayou is a protected Water of the United States and a source of life-giving water for animals and people within the Mill Bayou Watershed and therefore is not an appropriate use as a sewage pipe which will poison our waters and threaten our health. This developer is documented to be a "bad actor" with ADEQ and should not be allowed to install yet another failed sewage facility in Roland on Mill Bayou and not especially when the developer has other options.

Ann and I live ¼ of a mile from the proposed development and we are seriously concerned about every aspect of this project. The property is absolutely too dense of a development for this rural situation. As a community, we were all unaware of any public notice until the preliminary plat was approved by the county.
