Dear Mr. Khan,

I urge the ADEQ Water Quality Division to deny the above referenced sewage treatment facility.

This is a wholly unsuitable location for a project of this type. Approval of this permit will negatively impact adjacent and nearby landowners' properties. The hydrology in this area is unsuitable for treated sewage discharges of the volume proposed, and especially during seasonal flooding events. This sewage treatment plant and associated development will make the existing flooding problems even worse.

The current Waterview Estates sewage treatment facility has had consistent code violations. The same developer is proposing this plant. Why encourage past violators to add to the damage they are already doing by giving them a permit for yet another sewage treatment plant?

This is a public health issue for nearby landowners who have a right to enjoy their property. Their private property rights are just as important as those of this developer.

Again, I request that you deny this permit as being inappropriate and wholly unsuitable for this area, especially given the problematic history of the developer's other sewage treatment plant.
