Dear Mr. Khan,

I ask that ADEQ deny the permit for the sewage treatment facility for Paradise Valley and I also request a public hearing on this issue. Mill Bayou is a protected Water of the United States and a source of life-giving water for animals and people within the Mill Bayou Watershed and therefore is not an appropriate use as a sewage pipe which will poison our waters and threaten our health. This developer is documented to be a "bad actor" with ADEQ and should not be allowed to install yet another failed sewage facility in Roland on Mill Bayou and not especially when the developer has other options.

In addition to the above there is significant waterfowl traffic to the Mill Bayou during the fall/winter migration that would suffer from the reduced water quality. There is also the added vehicle traffic that would be added to the already growing traffic problem on Roland Cutoff.
