I ask that ADEQ deny the permit for the sewage treatment facility for Paradise Valley and I also request a public hearing on this issue if/when that time comes. Mill Bayou is not an appropriate use as a sewage facility's pipe - in this location especially.

I am one of several senior citizens living in the mountains. Public hearings need to be held and those of us who have been here, my sister-in-law for 80 years, deserve to be heard. I have grave concerns about the waterways downstream from me. I want to see ecological studies. Have they been thoroughly done and what will the effect be on all the wildlife in the area? A bunch of habitat has already been lost to the bulldozer for this proposed disaster of a plan. The waterways are only the beginnings of my concerns. Highway 300 struggles to keep up with the current traffic. That added traffic will also lead to significantly more rubber and petroleum products being washed into the watershed. It's a shame that the only thing taken into account is profit for a developer and a possible new tax base.
