I am a physician in the Little Rock area, practicing for 25 years.

In learning of the Paradise Valley development plan and the wastewater potential affecting Mill Bayou and surrounding communities of the Roland area, I was appalled in reading of this proposition.

Wastewater not only affects the local flora, fauna, and animal species, but the potential and almost certain affect on the human population is far reaching. Many of the inhabitants of the region are of advanced age with multiple comorbidities. To ingest the enteric pathogens of tainted water from waste can and will have long reaching and fatal effects on all age groups but especially those most at risk already.

I am firmly opposing this measure.
