Dear Mr. Khan,

I ask that ADEQ deny the permit for the sewage treatment facility for Paradise Valley and I also request a public hearing on this issue. Mill Bayou is a protected Water of the United States and a source of life-giving water for animals and people within the Mill Bayou Watershed and therefore is not an appropriate use as a sewage pipe which will poison our waters and threaten our health. This developer is documented to be a "bad actor" with ADEQ and should not be allowed to install yet another failed sewage facility in Roland on Mill Bayou and not especially when the developer has other options.

I moved out of Little Rock about 25 years ago to raise my family in a rural environment. We have really enjoyed it as such but now a proposed development of up to 450 houses just off Roland cutoff would change all of that. This development is completely out of character for this area and should not be allowed. We don't have the infrastructure to support such a development and the way of life for current residents is going to change dramatically if it is allowed to go ahead. I strongly oppose allowing this development to proceed.
