The developer eventually wants to build over 400 houses and I don't see how Mill Bayou can with stand that increase of water/sewage.

There are other issues that would make this development of over 400 houses detrimental to this area. One of them would be the increase of traffic on Highway 300 which is the only road to use to get to Little Rock, AR. Highway 300 is a narrow two lane road that is already handling many cars, bicycles, farm equipment a day. Also, there is no public transportation available out here.
