Dear Mr. Khan,

I ask that ADEQ deny the permit for the sewage treatment facility for Paradise Valley and I also request a public hearing on this issue. Mill Bayou is a protected Water of the United States and a source of life-giving water for animals and people within the Mill Bayou Watershed and therefore is not an appropriate use as a sewage pipe which will poison our waters and threaten our health. This developer is documented to be a "bad actor" with ADEQ and should not be allowed to install yet another failed sewage facility in Roland on Mill Bayou and not especially when the developer has other options.

We moved out here to enjoy breathing room, green space and quiet rural living. The waste water and storm runoff has increased since the Waterview Estates was developed and it flows down the ridge to our area. With this new projected leap frog development, the water issue will increase.

If the developer would divide the area into 3 acre lots with septic tanks, it would be more responsible and fit the rural lifestyle that we desire.

What would you do if your neighbors starting dumping their sewage into your backyard? It could happen if you didn't stop it before it happened. That is all we are trying to do.
