To the State:

I want to register a big NO to giving a permit for a new sewage treatment facility in the proposed Paradise Valley large scale tract home development.

I live on 40 acres of which two sides are bordered by Nowlin creek and a third tributary that feeds Nowlin. Our property would be down stream from the proposed sewage treatment center, which studies have shown would have potential "leakage" into the creeks and tributaries close to this planned Paradise Valley "subdivision".

If allowed to proceed as proposed, as many as 450 homes could be added to an area that is not situated to absorb this addition of; traffic, flooding, hazardous sewage, and general congestion, not to mention the probable contamination of Nowlin creek.

There are many other sites in the Roland and west Little Rock area for development of this type of planned tract home that would not endanger the community and creek of Roland.

Please do the research, evaluate the impact of placing 450 homes and thus the required sewage treatment on and in such a small community. Put the site where there is access to existing sewage treatment or away from Arkansas's natural waterways in Roland.
