Dear Mr. Khan,

I ask that ADEQ deny the permit for the sewage treatment facility for Paradise Valley and I also request a public hearing on this issue. Mill Bayou is a protected Water of the United States and a source of life-giving water for animals and people within the Mill Bayou Watershed and therefore is not an appropriate use as a sewage pipe which will poison our waters and threaten our health. This developer is documented to be a "bad actor" with ADEQ and should not be allowed to install yet another failed sewage facility in Roland on Mill Bayou and not especially when the developer has other options.

We do not want this in our community due to the fact that it will contribute to the pollution, busy the streets, and cause added chaos to an otherwise quiet community. I have lived here only 6 short months but the reasoning behind moving here was to provide a quiet, simple life for my husband, myself and our 2 kids.
