I ask that ADEQ deny the permit for the sewage treatment facility for Paradise Valley and I also request a public hearing on this issue if/when that time comes. Mill Bayou is not an appropriate use as a sewage facility's pipe - in this location especially.

Our home is located on property on Roland Cutoff Rd. With Mill Bayou running through it. We have a field adjacent to the bayou. When it rains one and a half to two inches this field will flood from the rain and runoff from the hills behind our house. This flooding has threatened our house in the past. Increased volume in the bayou would increase the threat of flooding in the wetlands not to mention the effect it would make on the land quality. More water should not be discharged in Mill Bayou.
