The Arkansas Department of Energy and Environment – Division of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Office of Water Quality, 5301 Northshore Drive, North Little Rock, Arkansas 72118-5317, will hold a Public Hearing regarding the proposed permit, Draft Permit No. AR0053210, for coverage under an individual NPDES discharge permit.

Applicant: Pulaski County Property Owners' Multipurpose Improvement District No. 2021-2 - Paradise Valley Subdivision WWTP facility, located as follows: Roland Cutoff, Roland, AR 72135 in Pulaski County. This is a new facility. The applicant proposes to discharge treated domestic wastewater effluent into an unnamed tributary of Mill Bayou, thence to Mill Bayou, thence to the Arkansas River in Segment 3C of the Arkansas River Basin. Pulaski County Property Owners' Multipurpose Improvement District No. 2021-2 - Paradise Valley Subdivision WWTP submitted an application on September 2, 2020, with all additional information required for the review of NPDES Permit No. AR0053210, received by January 18, 2022. A public comment period on the proposed draft permit closed on April 5, 2022. Based on comments and requests for a public hearing received during the public comment period, and in accordance with Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission (APC&EC) Rule No. 8.209, DEQ will conduct a public hearing.

The public hearing will be held on May 18, 2022, at 2:00 p.m. Central Time to accept comments on the draft permit. The hearing will be held in the Commission Room at the DEQ Headquarters Building, 5301 Northshore Drive, North Little Rock, AR 72118. In the event of inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances, a decision may be made to postpone the hearing. If the hearing is postponed and rescheduled, a new legal notice will be published to announce the details of the new hearing date and comment period. At said hearing, all interested parties may submit written or oral statements regarding the draft NPDES permit to the Hearing Officer for consideration. The purpose of said hearing is to allow public participation in the determination of the terms and conditions of the issuance of the NPDES permit. Verbal comments will be accepted, but written comments are preferred in the interest of accuracy. The comment period will be effective during the public hearing during the designated time and will expire at the close of the hearing.

Comments and public hearing procedures may be found at 40 C.F.R. §§ 124.10 through 124.12 and APC&EC Rule 8. All persons, including the applicant, who wish to comment on DEQ's draft permitting decision, must submit comments to DEQ, along with their name and mailing address. After the public comment period and public hearing, DEQ will render a final permitting decision. DEQ will notify the applicant and each person who has submitted written comments or requested notice of the final permitting decision. Any interested person who has submitted comments may appeal a final decision by DEQ in accordance with the APC&EC Rule 8.
