



PUBLIC NOTICE OF REVISED DRAFT DISCHARGE PERMIT AND 208 PLAN, PERMIT NUMBER ARO053210, AFIN 60-05010

This is a revised draft permit and re-publication of the draft for public comment. The public notice for the original draft permit was previously published on July 11, 2021, and the public comment period ended on August 11, 2021.

In accordance with Ark. Code Ann. § 8-4-203(e), the Arkansas Department of Energy and Environment – Division of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Office of Water Quality, gives the following notice:

Pulaski County Property Owners' Multipurpose Improvement District No. 2021-2 will operate the Paradise Valley Subdivision WWTP facility located as follows: Roland Cutoff, Roland, AR 72135 in Pulaski County. This is a new facility that is proposing to discharge treated domestic wastewater into an unnamed tributary of Mill Bayou, thence to Mill Bayou, thence to the Arkansas River in Segment 3C of the Arkansas River Basin. Pulaski County Property Owners' Multipurpose Improvement District No. 2021-2 - Paradise Valley Subdivision WWTP submitted an application on September 2, 2020, with all additional information received by January 18, 2022 for the issuance of NPDES Permit No. ARO053210. The application has been reviewed by the DEQ's Office of Water Quality and has received tentative approval subject to the terms of this notice.

The 208 Plan, developed by the DEQ under provisions of Section 208 of the federal Clean Water Act, is a comprehensive program to work toward achieving federal water goals in Arkansas. The initial 208 Plan, adopted in 1979, provides for annual updates, but can be revised more often if necessary. Updates to the 208 Plan have been proposed to add this new facility with the following water quality limitations. These updates have also been incorporated into the draft discharge permit.

May-October:
CBOD5/TSS/NH3-N/DO/TRC = 15/20.0/5.0/3.0/0.011 mg/l
November-March:
CBOD5/TSS/NH3-N/DO/TRC = 20/20.0/10.0/2.0/0.011 mg/l
April:
CBOD5/TSS/NH3-N/DO/TRC = 20/20.0/5.0/2.0/0.011 mg/l
Design flow (Q): 0.05 MGD

Comments on the draft issuance will be accepted in accordance with Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission (APC&EC) Rule 8.208. DEQ's contact person for submitting written comments on the draft permit or 208 Plan, or requesting a public hearing on the draft permit or the proposed changes to the 208 Plan, is Faizan Khan, at the above address and telephone number or by email at Water-Draft-Permit-Comment@adeq.state.ar.us.

The period for submitting comments on the draft permit and 208 Plan, and for requesting a public hearing, shall begin on the date of publication of the public notice and end at 4:30 P.M. (Central Time) on the 30th day after the publication date. If the last day of the comment period is a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the public comment period shall expire on the next day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday. For information regarding the actual publication date along with the actual date and time the comment period will end, please contact Faizan Khan at the above address and telephone number or by email at Water-Draft-Permit-Comment@adeq.state.ar.us. Public notice, comments, and hearings will be conducted in accordance with APC&EC Rules 6.104(A)(5) (40 C.F.R. §§ 124.10 through 124.12 by reference) and 8.207 through 8.210 (Administrative Procedures). All persons, including the permittee, who wish to comment on DEQ's draft permitting decision must submit written comments to DEQ, along with their name and mailing address. A Public Hearing will be held when DEQ finds a significant degree of public interest. After the public comment period, DEQ will issue a final permitting decision. DEQ will notify the applicant and each person who has submitted written comments or requested notice of the final permitting decision. Any interested person who has submitted comments may appeal a final decision by DEQ in accordance with the APC&EC Rule 8.
