Dear Permittee:

This letter is written to inform you that the Sanitary Landfill General Permit (ARG160000) expired on February 29, 2010 and the new permit was effective March 1, 2010. In accordance with Part 1.3.6, submittal of a renewal Notice of Intent (NOI) was required within 120 days of the effective date of the renewal permit in order for permit coverage to remain in effect. The Department sent a notice requiring a NOI renewal be submitted no later than June 30, 2010. Since the Department did not receive the renewal NOI within the required timeframe, your permit tracking number, ARG160003, is no longer valid.

If this letter is received in error, please contact the Department at (501) 682-0623 as soon as possible so that Department records can be corrected and updated. Any resumption of the discharge or any new discharge without a permit will be unlawful and may be subject to enforcement and fines. Should you again plan to discharge any pollutant from this outfall to waters of the State, it will be necessary to file a new notice of intent. Any permit issued as a result of such reapplication will contain conditions and limitations consistent with the situation, and the laws and regulations in effect at the time of reissuance, irrespective of any previously issued permit.
