The request by C & H to modify its NMP for fields 7,8 and 9 is troubling and I believe ADEQ should deny the modification request. The application is an admission by C & H that it is already having difficulty meeting the requirements of the original NMP and is not, in its first year of operation, able to adequately handle the wastes generated so far. Using a vac tanker on field 7, for example, requires repeated use of heavy vehicles on ground that is known to flood and will exacerbate the problem by compacting the soil and increasing run off. As is evident from the original permit application and the fact that several of these fields are not included in the U of A study, ADEQ is being presented with an NMP modification request on fields where incomplete or inaccurate information has been presented. Since field 7 is close to a school which puts children at risk, how can ADEQ possibly approve this modification?
