I am writing to request that the permit to allow a truck sprayer on Pond #2 at the C & H Hog Farm in Newton County be denied. Evidence from other similar operations show that the particulates released from spraying procedures pose a hazard to humans, especially to children. As you know, a school is located a relatively short distance from the CAFO in question and I am concerned for the safety of school children and other residents who would be negatively affected by the spraying. Also, due to the sensitive karst environment of this region, spraying or spreading large amounts of effluent threatens the water quality of the Buffalo National River and its watershed. The Buffalo is a mainstay of the economy in this part of the state. It is, also, a national treasure with which we in Arkansas have been entrusted. Respectfully, I ask that this permission to spray be denied. Additionally, I would ask that a thorough Environmental Assessment be required to determine the future of this CAFO in such an environmentally sensitive area.
