I oppose any and all modifications to the existing permit for C & H in Mt. Judea, Arkansas, without first opening the entire permit.

The permit has an inaccurate and insufficient nutrient management plan. This revision ignores the inaccuracies and insufficiencies and yet calls for spreading waste by a different method, from pond 1 onto fields 7-9. No slurry from pond 1 should be applied anywhere because of the higher concentration of Phosphorus. Field 7 is already high in nutrients. Field 7 is in the flood plain. Just last week-end, after a less than 3" rain, field 7 had a large pool of water at the edge, running right into Big Creek. (See attached photos.) Our family lives just downstream from field 7 and field 7 is right across from the public school and town of Mt. Judea. The risk of manure leeching or flooding into Big Creek is too great. The hog waste can't be cleaned up or taken back once it enters the ground and waters.

The **method** of spreading hog sewage should not be considered until all of the problems with the nutrient management plan are resolved. I ask that the permit be pulled for spreading/spraying any hog waste on fields lying next to Big Creek and remove field 7 from the emergency plan. Please deny this revision and re-open this entire permit.
