Please enlighten me on this latest issue.

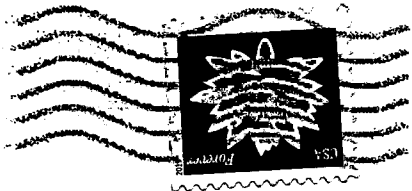
