C&H is operating pursuant to the Nutrient Management Plan, as initially approved by ADEQ when Notice of Coverage (Tracking Number ARG590001) was issued on August 3, 2012, with the limitations regarding Fields 5, 12 and 16 as described in ADEQ's responses to Frequently Asked Questions (see Response to Question 13), and including two substantial changes to the Nutrient Management Plan approved by ADEQ on June 4, 2014 and May 5, 2015. A third substantial Change to Permit ARG590001 authorized installation of synthetic liners, but that work has been deferred pending receipt of an individual NPDES permit for the facility.
