Dear Mr. Henson:

The Department has received your Nutrient Management Plan cool season application rates for the above referenced permit on December 30, 2013. Please be advised, you are not required to submit your application rates for every application. However, you must submit all application rates with your annual report in accordance with Condition 3.2.4 of the General Permit.

During the review of your cool season application rates, the Department noticed that the proposed application rate for Field No. 15 of 10,000 gallons/acre exceeded your Nutrient Management Plan application rate of 9,900 gallons/acre. If C & H is proposing to apply waste at a higher rate than previously approved, you will need to submit a Notice of Intent and a Nutrient Management Plan to modify your permit. Otherwise, apply at rates previously approved in the Notice of Coverage issued on August 3, 2012 for Field No. 15.
