As a BRWA supporter, I am very concerned about the public health in the Jasper area. Many communities of people in similar circumstances -- where spreaders have been used to evacuate untreated pig waste -- have fallen very ill after a considerably short period of time.

As if this weren't bad enough, this Hog Factory Farm will not only affect the beauty of our "Natural State," but also the navigability and scenic wonder of the Buffalo River, and hence the Tourism industry in the Jasper area.

I am gravely concerned about the environmental studies down beforehand being rigged. I know there is a more sustainable and humane way to raise pigs.
